- ECG monitoring
- height, weight and BMI measurements



Emphasis is placed upon medico-legal aspects, communication, health and safety and critical awareness/reflection on practice.

Students are required to meet the competencies as indicated within the clinical skills practice booklet. Following successful completion students are awarded 15 SCOTCAT credits at level 7.

Students attend the university for four days. Mentors are invited to attend on the afternoon of the fourth day. Two evaluation days are arranged approximately six and 12 weeks after the initial course.
