Directions

Rail or Bus – take a taxi to the accommodation

By Car – via the Kingsway bypass follow signs for Aberdeen (A90) the Halls are close to the Forfar/Aberdeen junction.

From Alloway to the University – Buses run regularly from 2 bus stops close to the residence and take approximately 15 mins to get to the University Campus. See www.traveldundee.co.uk/index.asp for further information and times.

Flats 7-18 were up-graded in 2008 with new kitchens, new and extra showering facilities and 'hard wired' Broadband in every room supplied free of charges.

Prices

The prices per week are £64.75 for a standard room and £79.45 for an up-graded room. Payment can be made in full up front [gaining a 2.5% discount] or on a monthly basis by direct debit, online via The University Portal [OASIS], at the Finance Office Cash desk or over the phone by calling 01382 308027 from a UK landline/Mobile.

If paying by monthly instalments, 9 equal payments of £273.39 or £335.46 will be due to be paid. 1 during the lease acceptance process, then 8 further payments from 20th Oct 2011 – 20th May 2012 inclusive.

All other methods of payment must be made by the 1st of each month, Oct-May inclusive.

Alloway Halls is reserved for first year students new to the city (typically 16-19 years of age). Situated to the north of Dundee, the residence enjoys excellent views of the Sidlaw Hills and has easy access to the main travel routes.

There are 144 bed rooms divided into self catering flats of 8. You'll find a comfortable study bedroom with desk, chair and wardrobe, and a communal kitchen/living room.

There is a coin meter in each kitchen in flats 1-6 (standard flats only), which operates all sockets within the flat. Alloway has a coin operated laundry, controlled entry system, gas central heating, free car parking, a payphone in each block, free Contents Insurance and Portable Appliance Testing.

You can collect your keys from the Caretaker's Office on either 10th or 11th Sept between 10am-4pm. If you cannot arrive during these dates/times, please call the caretaker in advance to make alternative arrangements.

Nil deposit but a prepayment of rent will be required. Details of the amount due will depend on the room type and can be found on our website www.abertay.ac.uk/studying/accommodation/
