

Accounting with Finance

Trained professional management/business accountants are in increasing demand from management consultants and organisations in general as professionals who understand the business from a holistic viewpoint. The accountant needs to understand the whole operation of the business in order to add value to the organisation, and show stronger commercial awareness, whilst being able to manage and use financial systems. If you want to acquire a wide-ranging finance and business qualification, then the Accounting with Finance course is ideal.

This programme provides a thorough and contemporary knowledge of the business and financial processes of an organisation. You will have the opportunity to study a range of subject areas which may include Management Accounting, Financial Accounting, Law, Economics, Corporate Finance and Contemporary Business. As well as developing essential accounting and finance skills, the course encourages you to develop problem solving and decision-making skills invaluable to employers.

Core Themes

The Accounting with Finance programme offers students with an HND in Accounting or the equivalent an opportunity to specialise in Finance within a general framework of an Accounting qualification

The BA (Hons) Accounting with Finance was designed using modules which are clustered around the following main themes, some of which may be offered as options:		
T1	Financial Accounting	The preparation and interpretation of financial accounts for external stakeholders. The evaluation of the concepts that underpin the accounting process.
T2	Management Accounting	The preparation of financial reports from historical and projected information, for the internal stakeholder.
T3	Corporate Finance	The raising, spending or investing of funds and the risk management thereof.
T4	Taxation	Knowledge, understanding and application of UK tax regulations to personal and corporate situations
T5	Economics	Understanding the economy at both the micro and macro levels and using economic models to interpret financial information and aid decision making
T6	Professional Issues	Building an awareness of the accounting environment. For example the business context, IT, business and corporate law, environmental and social issues and ethics

Career opportunities

The programme offers a wide choice of career opportunities in both the public and private sectors. Opportunities include achieving a professional accounting qualification, careers in business management, the financial sector, in banking or financial advising.

Professional Accreditation

The degree has been developed with careful consideration given to content matching with the relevant bodies and it is anticipated that the degree will attract accreditation from the professional bodies. In addition to the formal accreditation arrangement, students can seek individual examination exemptions from other relevant financial professional bodies such as the Association of Corporate Treasurers and the Chartered Institute of Banking in Scotland.
