# Note A – Your Details

**Surname:** Please make sure you tell us your SURNAME (also known as FAMILY NAME) and your GIVEN NAMES. The University uses your Surname to address all your correspondence and, if your application is successful, it is the name used in our students records systems.

Example 1 - My name is Julie McEwan. McEWAN is my FAMILY NAME and JULIE is my GIVEN NAME.

Example 2 – My name is Rei Xin Ming. REI is my FAMILY NAME and XIN MING is my GIVEN NAME.

**Date of Birth:** Please enter the year you were born. It is not the year of application. It should be in the following format: 12 July 1982 or 12/07/1982

**Address:** Once you have sent in your form you must tell us if either your Permanent Home Address or your Address for Correspondence change. Letters will be sent to whichever address you have nominated as your CORRESPONDENCE address. out.

A good personal statement could make the difference between being offered a place or being rejected.
