## Scholarship Information

The Ninja Kiwi Scholarship is open to students who are entering Year 4 of the following Games courses:

- Computer Arts
- Computer Games Application Development
- Computer Games Technology
- Game Design and Production

This one-year scholarship of £1,500 is aimed at a well-rounded individual who is considered academically bright, driven, ambitious and interested to work in the games industry.

The successful candidate will also undertake a 4 week paid placement at Ninja Kiwi as the culmination of their scholarship. The candidate will join one of the development teams; however this will depend on their experience and the course that they are studying. There will also be opportunities to work in other areas of the organisation such as marketing materials and extra tools. Further information on the work placement will be discussed during the interview.

The placement will begin at the end of May 2019 or early June 2019 in the Dundee Office. Hours of work will be Monday to Friday 9am – 5pm.

## Further Information - Ninja Kiwi Europe

Ninja Kiwi is one of the world's leading developers and publishers for web and mobile. Founded as Digital Goldfish in 2005 by two graduates from Abertay University the company went on to be acquired in 2012 by New Zealand based Ninja Kiwi. They have accumulated over 100 million downloads on the AppStores. Their hit franchises include Bloons, Bloons TD and SAS: Zombie Assault. Ninja Kiwi office in Dundee is co-managed by Abertay graduates' David Hamilton and Barry Petrie.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be considered for this scholarship you must meet <u>all</u> of the following criteria:

Be commencing Year 4 of any of the above games courses mentioned.

• Take part in the 4-week work placement at Ninja Kiwi. Exact date to be confirmed but it is

anticipated that the students must be available to start at the end of May 2019 or beginning

of June 2019

Able to demonstrate in the application form that that you are ambitious and keen to work in

the games industry.

• Be willing to take part in publicity materials for the scholarship if successful.

Be willing to meet a Ninja Kiwi Representative and/or write a letter of thanks for the

scholarship if successful.

What kind of funding is available?

A £1,500 scholarship will be awarded to one successful applicant. The award will be paid in two

instalments.

First instalment: November 2018

Second instalment: March/April 2019

Paid 4-week summer work placement -Pay will be agreed prior to the successful student being

asked to accept the scholarship.
