SCHOLARSHIP BACKGROUND AND INFORMATION

The Bonar Yarns Scholarship will be awarded to one 4th year student on the Marketing and Business degree.

Students who are first in their family to attend higher education and from a low-income background will benefit from the scholarship. However, the student who is considered academically bright, driven, ambitious and keen to work in the marketing and business sector will receive the scholarship.

History of Bonar Yarns

Bonar Yarns was founded in 1914 as a subsidiary of the already established Low and Bonar Company and is now a world-leading manufacturer of synthetic grass and carpet fibres. They have been involved with Abertay's Business School in various activities over the past couple of years including Innovation for Global Growth, and Live Assessments. As well as donating a scholarship they are also offering a prize to a 2nd year Marketing and Business student.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for this scholarship students must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- Be commencing 4th Year in the BA(Hons) Marketing and Business degree in September 2018
- Be able to demonstrate a financial need for support
- Be able to show that your academic grades have improved throughout your degree or that you have had consistently high marks in each year of study

- Be willing to meet a Bonar Yarns Representative and/or write a letter of thanks for the scholarship if successful
- Be willing to take part in publicity materials for the scholarship if successful

WHAT KIND OF FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

A £1,250 scholarship will be awarded to one successful applicant. The award will be paid in two instalments.

First instalment: November 2018

Second instalment: May 2019

HOW CAN I APPLY?

Applications may be downloaded and completed on a device or printed and completed by hand. A typed signature may be accepted where the application has been completed electrically.

EVIDENCE AND DEADLINE

Please complete the application form and submit with the evidence requested by the closing date as stated below.

Evidence to be attached:

- A written Academic Reference i.e. from a Lecturer or Tutor
- Student Funding Letter of Award (SAAS / Student Finance award letter/Other sponsor if applicable)
- Please note students may be asked to provide further proof of their financial circumstances. If so, you will be required to provide 2 months recent and consecutive bank statements from each account that you hold.

Closing date: **Monday 5th November 2018**

Completed applications and evidence should be submitted to the Advisory Service in one of the following ways:
