

REMUNERATION COMMITTEE: REMIT AND MEMBERSHIP SESSION 2018/19

Remit

- (i) To consider and determine the levels of salary and conditions of service (including severance arrangements if appropriate) of the senior officers of the University, namely the Principal & Vice-Chancellor, the Vice-Principal & Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), the Vice-Principal & Deputy Vice-Chancellor (University Services) and the University Secretary.
- (ii) To decide the principles for determining the salaries of all other University staff whose salaries are in the discretionary range above the nationally-determined salary scale.

Membership

The Chair of Court

The Vice-Chair of Court

The Chair of the Finance & Corporate Performance Committee

Two other lay members of Court (excluding the Chair of Audit & Risk Committee)

The student member of Court

One staff member of Court (excluding those where there is clear conflict of interest)

[The chair of the Committee should be appointed by Court from amongst the independent members, excluding the Chair of Court.]

In attendance

The Principal (when the salary and conditions of service of the Principal are <u>no</u>t the subject of discussion)

Director of HR & Organisational Development (as and when professional advice is required)

Secretary

University Secretary (except when his/her salary and conditions of service are being discussed)

Quorum

Normally all members, but exceptionally at least 5 members (to include Chair or Vice-Chair).
