SCHOLARSHIP BACKGROUND AND INFORMATION

These scholarships are offered by Academic Schools within the University to undertake research in areas of strategic priority.

Successful candidates may also be expected to undertake placement, professional practice, ambassadorial or other activity related to researcher professional development (this will be clearly stated within the Scholarship Offer Letter).

All offers are also subject to the current Regulations for Research Degree Programmes.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates that have received an offer for Postgraduate Research Degree study from Abertay University are eligible to apply. The candidates research topic must fall within a priority strategic area of research, as detailed on the Research pages of the Abertay University Website, and their case for support must be exceptional. <https://www.abertay.ac.uk/research/>

Applications will be accepted from any student, regardless of their country of origin.

Successful students must be willing to meet the award conditions set out in the Award Conditions section below.

WHAT KIND OF FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

The award of the Abertay Futures Scholarship is at the discretion of the University and is initially for one full year of tuition fees. Continuation of the award is dependent upon the successful fulfilment of all conditions stated in the offer letter, and the successful progress of the candidate through Annual Progression Review.

The award will be applied to the successful applicant's tuition fee accounts at the time of registration and will be equivalent to the registration fee regardless of their country of origin.

It is at the Decision Making Panel's discretion to make an award or a number of awards in any academic year/semester.

AWARD CONDITIONS

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| <p>1. <i>The candidate is, as part of their professional development and practice, expected to support ambassadorial activities by engaging with a range of stakeholders. This activity will on average be no more than 3hours/week. The Head(s) of Division will ensure that the candidate is appropriately attributed in any associated research output and that the work complements and enables progression of the candidate's studies.</i></p> |
