- Getting a taste of a subject– whether it's right for you.
- Narrowing down which course, within a subject area, you'd be interested in studying.
- Getting a flavour of life as a student at Abertay.

How to spend the day

Open Days are like a menu – you can pick what you want. The 'specials of the day' are:

Scheduled times

- Subject talks and activities such as tours and demos with lecturers and current students.
- General talks – student funding; accommodation; coming from college, sports.
- Tours – campus; library; accommodation.

Drop in

- Advice and information stands.
- Academic School basecamps to talk one-on-one with lecturers and students.
- Accommodation Information Hub.

Tours and Visits

Campus Tours | 12.00noon - 5.00pm

Leaving every 30 mins from the Kydd Building Reception. Last tour leaves at 4.30pm.

Duration: 20-30 mins

Our campus is small but perfectly formed. Get a feel for it by taking one of our guided tours.

Library Tours | 12.15pm - 5.00pm

Leaving every 30 mins from the Library foyer starting from 12.15am. Last tour leaves at 4.30pm.
